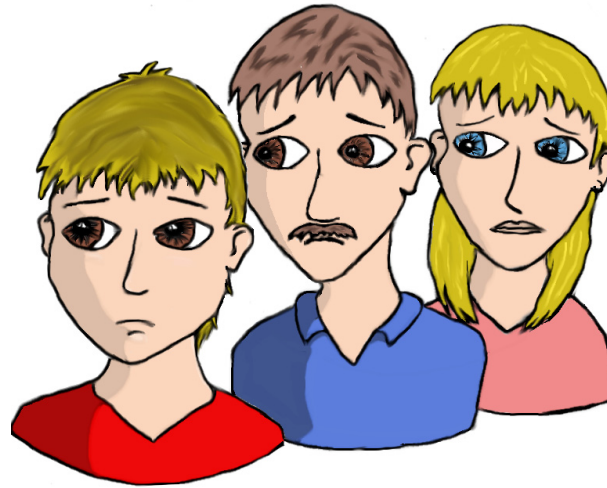


SAAM provides the means to reverse the damaging effects of alcoholism/substance abuse. For an individual, identification and treatment can mean increased self esteem and personal happiness, with significant reductions in family dysfunction, violence and criminal behavior.

Experienced, state-qualified alcohol and drug counselors provide confidential assessment to determine substance abuse problems, the extent of the problem and amenability to treatment. Following assessment, counselors provide recommendations for an appropriate, individualized recovery plan.

In addition to referral and placement in treatment programs, SAAM provides ongoing monitoring, support and guidance for the recovering person.
