

Program Details

- Minimum of 12 months in the program
- At least 4 months of abstinence prior to graduation
- 5 phases of recovery to complete
- Random alcohol/drug testing on a color system
- Group therapy
- Individual therapy



Eligibility

- You have been diagnosed chemically dependent
- You live in Spokane County
- You have no hold from another jurisdiction
- The amount of restitution does not exceed \$2500
- You are willing to participate in an intensive alcohol/drug treatment program to deal with your addiction and address addiction-related issues.
- There is a reasonable basis to believe you can successfully complete the Drug Court Program.
- Charged in Spokane County Superior Court with a drug-related felony. The following exceptions will preclude a client from Drug Court:
 - There is an indication of intent to sell or production of drugs
 - You have a current or prior violent or sex offense
 - You have other pending felony charges which have not been incorporated into your Drug Court offense
